SPONSORSHIP

Camp SMILE's Weekend Respite Camp is sponsored by United Cerebral Palsy of Mobile.

FACILITIES

Camp Grace is a privately owned and operated property that encompasses over 220 acres. Some of the amenities include: 48 air conditioned log cabins, 3 air conditioned multipurpose buildings, a 60'x80' pavilion/dining area, an 18 acre lake, a lighted Odyssey III high ropes course and various low ropes areas.

MEDICAL CARE

Two registered nurses and a licensed paramedic are on duty 24 hours a day during each camp session. An additional nurse is on site from 7am-7pm, as needed.

COUNSELORS

An adequate number of mature, trained counselors will be assigned to campers according to their needs. Trained adults will supervise activities in each cabin.

WHAT TO BRING: All items must be properly labeled to insure safe return.

IT IS NECESSARY TO BRING ENOUGH CLOTHING FOR A CHANGE EACH DAY

You must also send your own supply of wipes, diapers, swim diapers and pediasure/ensure, if used by camper.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Jewelry, candy, chewing gum and anything with peanut butter should not be brought to camp. Radios, tape players, cell phones, etc...may only be brought with permission of camp directors. No money is necessary for food; three meals and two snacks per day are provided. However, there will be camp items available for purchase at check in.

ARRIVAL

Camper check- in is on Friday evening at 5:30 p.m. Plan to spend at least 30 minutes checking in your camper. Please take advantage of this time to share important information about your camper with the nurse and his/her counselor.

DEPARTURE

Check -out for campers is **Sunday morning** at 9:30 a.m. Campers may be picked up at the big top.

Transportation to and from camp is the responsibility of the camper's family/guardian. A map and complete driving directions will be mailed with your confirmation packet.
